

HOWEVER, THE 2" BANDAID SEALANT STRIP SHALL BE DELETED TO PREVENT UNNECESSARY DAMAGE TO THE EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS. ALL DAMAGES TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKINGS IN EXCESS OF THAT CAUSED BY THE ROUTING OPERATION SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE EXPENSE OF THE CONTRACTOR.
- ANY RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS ENCOUNTERED SHALL BE LEFT IN PLACE. ROUTING SHALL BE GAPPED WHERE RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS ARE ENCOUNTERED SO AS TO LEAVE THEM FUNCTIONAL.
- AN APPLICATION RATE OF 0.33 LBS/FT WAS USED TO DETERMINE THE QUANTITY OF CRACK FILLING.
- RESIDENT ENGINEER SHALL DETERMINE THE EXACT LOCATIONS WHERE CRACKS ARE TO BE ROUTED AND FILLED.
