Dear Mr. Bunting:

This is in response to your request for authorization to replace a deficient bridge on TR 151 over an unnamed tributary of Bonpas Creek with a precast pre-stressed bridge. The project would also include the relocation of 243 feet of stream channel. In order to stabilize the new stream channel, 0.0955 acres of rip rap would be placed on the sides and bottom of the channel. The project is located south of Bellmont in Wabash County, IL. The information supplied by you was reviewed to determine whether a Department of the Army (DA) permit will be required under the provisions of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.

Your project is considered a discharge of fill for a road crossing. The project is authorized under the provisions of 33 CFR 330 Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 14, Linear Transportation Crossings, as published in the Federal Register March 19, 2007. Under the provisions of this authorization you must comply with the enclosed:

1. Terms for Nationwide Permit No. 14
2. Nationwide Permit General Conditions

You must also obtain an individual State 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) or waiver from the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (ILEPA). You may contact them directly at the following address:

ISSUE OF 401 PERMIT: The issue of the Water Quality 401 Permit is not included in the contract. Until, the Department obtains the permit, no work subject to a 401 permit shall be started until written notification is given by the Department of the permit.

Work subject to the 401 permit includes: cofferdams, channel changes, channel excavation, construction haul roads, work pads, wing dams, riprap placement, bank excavation, and other similar work or activities which modify or otherwise affect waters of the United States, including stream beds, stream banks, and connected wetlands.

The 401 permit is anticipated to be in place February 2, 2009.

No working days will be charged when the 401 permit affects the controlling item.
