US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS PERMITTING

It is the contractors responsibility to obtain a US Army Corps of Engineers 404 Permit for the removal of the pier protection cell. As the contractor will be responsible for selecting the removal method, the permit for the existing pier cell removal cannot be applied for until the removal method is known. IDOT will be available to provide some assistance in the permitting process. The contact at the US Army Corps of Engineers is Alan Edmonson - ACOE St. Louis District, phone 314-331-2811

US Coast Guard and Army Corps of Engineers 404 permits for the construction of the new pier cell are anticipated to be issued by the time of letting.
