## **BICYCLE RAILING (GROUND MOUNTED)**

<u>Description</u>: This item shall consist of fabricating, furnishing, and erecting a bicycle railing to match the bicycle railing detailed on the structural plans and in accordance with the applicable requirements of Section 509 of the Standard Specifications except as modified herein.

The bicycle railing shall be installed onto the on 12" circular foundations. The foundations shall be a depth of 4 foot deep.

<u>Shop Drawings</u>: The Contractor shall submit detailed shop drawings in accordance with Article 509.04 of the Standard Specification to the Engineer for approval before fabrication is begun.

<u>Fabrication</u>: Fabrication of the bicycle railing shall conform to Article 509.05 of the Standard Specification the handrail shall be hot-dipped galvanized conforming to the requirements of ASTM A123, Coating Grade 50 after fabrication.

<u>Installation</u>: The fence shall be installed in accordance with the following:

- Concrete Set Posts. Brill hole in firm, undisturbed, or compacted soil. Holes shall have a diameter of at least 12 inches and depths approximately 4 foot deep Excavate deeper as required for adequate support in soft and loose soils and for posts with heavy lateral loads. Set post bottom 48" below surface when in firm, undisturbed soil. Place concrete around post in a continuous pour. Trowel finish around posts and slope to direct water away from posts. Concrete shall be Class SI.
- Check each post for vertical and top alignment and maintain in position during placement and finish operation.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per Foot for BICYCLE RAILING (GROUND MOUNTED), which price shall include all materials, mounting, foundation, excavation, fabrication, transportation, and erection.
