- DROP SHALL BE REMOVED AFTER THE PROPOSED LIGHTING SYSTEM IS FULLY OPERATIONAL. REMOVED AS APPLICABLE.
- DISRUPTED DURING EXISTING PAVEMENT REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE TO COORDINATE WITH THE ROADWAY CONSTRUCTION STAGES. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING UNIT DUCTS IN CONDUIT CROSSING THE ROADWAY SHALL BE REPLACED IN KIND THE SAME DAY SUCH THAT LIGHTING SYSTEM IS FULLY OPERATIONAL BEFORE NIGHT. THIS WORK SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER AND AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE STATE.
- CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE MAINTAIN THE EXISTING UNDERPASS LIGHTING UNDER THE WESTBOUND U.S. ROUTE 30 BRIDGE DECK OPERATIONAL IF NOT AFFECTED BY THE BRIDGE DECK REMOVAL. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE THE PROPOSED UNDERPASS LIGHTING UNDER THE EASTBOUND U.S. ROUTE 30 BRIDGE DECK OPERATIONAL BEFORE REMOVING THE EXISTING UNDERPASS LIGHTING UNDER THE WESTBOUND U.S. ROUTE 30 BRIDGE DECK. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE MAINTENANCE OF LIGHTING SYSTEM PAY ITEM.
- AND FROM THE JUNCTION BOX TO THE EXISTING HIGH MAST LIGHTING TOWER SHALL BE ADJUSTED OR RE-ROUTED TO MAINTAIN EXISTING LIGHTING SYSTEM OPERATIONAL DURING CONSTRUCTION IF DEEMED NECESSARY DURING EXCAVATION WORK FOR THE BRIDGE PIER EXTENSION CONSTRUCTION. THIS WORK SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE MAINTENANCE OF LIGHTING SYSTEM PAY ITEM.
