


- THE PROJECT PAY ITEMS ARE INTENDED TO BE INCLUSIVE OF ALL WORK TO BE PERFORMED AS SHOWN IN THESE PLANS. ALL INCIDENTAL WORK REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE PROJECT TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE RESIDENT ENGINEER IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE COSTS OF PERFORMING THESE ITEMS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH ALL LABOR, MATERIAL, EQUIPMENT, AND TRANSPORTATION NECESSARY TO CONSTRUCT ALL ELEMENTS OF THE PROJECT AS DESCRIBED IN THE CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS.
- 2. THE RULES, REGULATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS ENUMERATED HEREIN SHALL BE CONSIDERED AS MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS. THEY SHALL NOT PROHIBIT THE CONTRACTOR FROM FURNISHING AND INSTALLING HIGHER GRADES OF MATERIAL THAN ARE SPECIFIED HEREIN, IF APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER
- 3. ACCESS TO THE SITE SHALL BE RESTRICTED EXCLUSIVELY TO THE DESIGNATED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE, STAGING AREA, AND HAUL ROUTE. NO EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL SHALL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE GENERAL PROJECT AREA.
- 4. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO PROTECT AND KEEP CLEAN OF DEBRIS ALL EXISTING AIRFIELD AND ROADWAY PAVEMENTS AT ALL TIMES. ANY DAMAGE TO EXISTING ELECTRICAL, DRAINAGE, AND PAVEMENT STRUCTURES SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY REPAIRED AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE CONTRACT.
- 5. CONTRACTOR IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE THEIR OWN RESTROOM FACILITIES.
- 6. THE OWNER SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL FOR ALL SALVAGEABLE MATERIAL REMOVED ON THE PROJECT.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING PERMITS FOR HAULING ON PUBLIC ROADS, AS APPLICABLE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CORRECTING ANY DAMAGES TO ANY PAVEMENTS (PUBLIC OR PRIVATE) CAUSED BY HIS/HER CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT OR PERSONNEL.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR MUST AT ALL TIMES MAINTAIN PROPER DRAINAGE AND EROSION CONTROL FOR ALL AREAS AFFECTED BY HIS WORK.
- 9. NPDES PERMIT THIS PROJECT WILL NOT DISTURB MORE THAN 1 ACRE, THEREFORE A NPDES PERMIT IS NOT REQUIRED.
- 10. MATERIAL CERTIFICATIONS MATERIALS CANNOT BE INSTALLED UNTIL ALL THE MATERIAL CERTIFICATIONS FOR THAT ITEM HAVE BEEN RECEIVED, REVIEWED AND ACCEPTED BY THE RESIDENT ENGINEER. MATERIALS INSTALLED WITHOUT APPROVAL ARE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.
- 11. <u>CERTIFIED PAYROLLS</u> THE RESIDENT ENGINEER <u>CANNOT</u> FORWARD A CONSTRUCTION REPORT FOR PAYMENT TO THE IDOT-DIVISION OF AERONAUTICS FOR PROCESSING UNTIL <u>ALL</u> CERTIFIED PAYROLLS FOR THAT PERIOD HAVE BEEN RECEIVED.

UTILI<u>TY NOTE</u>



CONSTRUCTION SAFETY PLAN

- GENERAL THE TRI-TOWNSHIP AIRPORT IS A GENERAL AVIATION AIRPORT COMPRISED OF 4.000' X 75' PAVED ASPHALT RUNWAY 13-31. 1 WITH ACCESS TAXIWAY AND TWO RAMP AREAS. THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION WILL REQUIRE THE DAYTIME-ONLY CLOSURE OF THE RUNWAY FOR A PORTION OF PROJECT
- 2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION THIS PROJECT SHALL CONSIST OF REMOVING VEGETATIVE OBSTRUCTIONS WITHIN THE PROTECTIVE AIRSPACE AROUND THE APPROACHES AND SIDES OF THE RUNWAY. PROJECT INCLUDES TREE REMOVAL, SEEDING, AND RESTORATION.
- AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS AREA AT NO TIME MAY THE CONTRACTOR WORK INSIDE THE AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS AREA (AOA) WHILE IT IS 3 ACTIVE. ANY WORK DONE INSIDE THIS AREAS WILL REQUIRE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE RUNWAY. THE AOA FOR RUNWAY 13-31 IS GOVERNED BY THE RUNWAY OBSTACLE FREE ZONE (OFZ) TO A WIDTH OF 125' FROM THE RUNWAY CENTERLINE, AND THE THRESHOLD SITING SURFACE (TSS) STARTING OFF EACH RUNWAY END AND RISING AT A SLOPE OF 20:1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL STAKE OR MARK THESE LIMITS PRIOR TO THE START OF WORK WITH A WOODEN LATHE AT 100' INTERVALS OR OTHER FORM OF EASILY VISIBLE MARKING.
- 4. WORK AREAS
- WORK AREA 1 WORK AREA 1 COVERS ALL WORK TO BE PERFORMED WITHIN THE AOA 125' OF THE RUNWAY CENTERLINE OR 4.1. WITHIN THE THRESHOLD SITING SURFACE LIMITS, AND WILL REQUIRE THE CLOSURE OF RUNWAY 13-31. THE CONTRACTOR WILL HAVE THREE DAYS TO COMPLETE THIS WORK. THE RUNWAY SHALL BE REOPENED AT THE END OF EACH DAY. NO OVERNIGHT CLOSURES WILL BE PERMITTED UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE AIRPORT MANAGER.
- WORK AREA 2 WORK AREA 2 COVERS ALL REMAINING WORK OUTSIDE OF THE AOA, AND DOES NOT REQUIRE CLOSURE OF ANY 4.2. AIRFIELD PAVEMENTS.
- 5. ALL RUNWAY/TAXIWAY CLOSURES SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH THE AIRPORT MANAGER A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS BEFORE THE DESIRED CLOSING TIME. THE AIRPORT MANAGER HAS COMPLETE AUTHORITY IN DETERMINING WHEN THE RUNWAY/TAXIWAY MAY BE CLOSED.
 - RUNWAY/TAXIWAY CLOSURE PROCEDURES: • CONTACT THE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT OR ASSIGNED REPRESENTATIVE A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS BEFORE THE DESIRED CLOSING TIME. • ISSUANCE OF NOTAM AND DEACTIVATION OF THE APPLICABLE AIRFIELD LIGHTING AND NAVAIDS BY THE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT AND/OR FAA. • PLACEMENT OF CROSSES AND BARRICADES.
 - ONLY AT THE TIME THAT ALL OF THE ABOVE ARE COMPLETED MAY ANY CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS BEGIN WITHIN THE RUNWAY/TAXIWAY AIR OPERATIONS AREA.

RUNWAY/TAXIWAY RE-OPENING PROCEDURES:

- ENSURE ALL PERSONNEL, EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS ARE CLEAR OF THE AIR OPERATIONS AREA. INSPECT THE AREA FOR LOOSE OR TRACKED DEBRIS, PAVEMENT DROP-OFFS, AND OPEN TRENCHES.
 CONTACT AIRPORT MANAGEMENT OR REPRESENTATIVE FOR FINAL INSPECTION OF THE AREA. • REMOVE BARRICADES AND CROSSES.
- ACTIVATION OF THE AIRFIELD LIGHTING AND NAVAIDS AND CANCELLATION OF THE NOTAM BY THE AIRPORT MANAGEMENT AND/OR FAA.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE A WRITTEN STATEMENT OF HIS ACCEPTANCE AND ASSURANCE THAT HE WILL COMPLY WITH THE 6. PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION SAFETY AND PHASING PLAN PRIOR TO BEING ISSUED THE NOTICE TO PROCEED.
- 7. REFER TO THE CONSTRUCTION SAFETY NOTES & DETAILS SHEET FOR ADDITIONAL SAFETY INFORMATION.




- 1. ALL PROVISIONS OF THE LATEST EDITION OF FAA ADVISORY CIRCULAR AC 150/5370-2 (CURRENT EDITION), "OPERATIONAL SAFETY ON AIRPORTS DURING CONSTRUCTION", APPLY TO THIS CONTRACT, EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THIS SAFETY PLAN. OR AS MODIFIED BY THE OWNER THROUGH THE RESIDENT ENGINEER / TECHNICIAN.
- 2. ALL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE WORK AND MATERIALS INVOLVING CONSTRUCTION SAFETY & PHASING AS SHOWN OR DESCRIBED IN THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, OR AS OTHERWISE DIRECTED BY THE RESIDENT ENGINEER/TECHNICIAN OR AIRPORT MANAGER THROUGHOUT THE PROJECT, SHALL BE INCIDENTAL TO THE CONTRACT
- AIRFIELD SAFETY ASSURANCE AIRFIELD SAFETY SHALL BE HELD PARAMOUNT AT ALL TIMES. ANY INDIVIDUALS RESPONSIBLE FOR INCURSIONS OR POTENTIAL 3. INCURSIONS WITH AIR TRAFFIC DUE TO NON-COMPLIANCE WITH REQUIREMENTS SET FOR IN THESE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, SPECIAL PROVISIONS, AND FAA ADVISORY CIRCULAR 150/5370-2F WILL BE SUBJECT TO AN IMMEDIATE SUSPENSION OF DRIVING PRIVILEGES ON THE AIRPORT OR A COMPLETE RESTRICTION OF ACCESS TO THE AIRFIELD ALTOGETHER. THE AIRPORT MANAGER OR RESIDENT ENGINEER/TECHNICIAN MAY STOP THE WORK AT ANY TIME THEY BELIEVE AIRFIELD SAFETY IS BEING COMPROMISED.
- 4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE THE AIRPORT MANAGER AND RESIDENT ENGINEER/TECHNICIAN WITH CONTACT INFORMATION FOR A PERSON ON CALL 24 HOURS A DAY FOR EMERGENCY MAINTENANCE OF BARRICADES AND HAZARD LIGHTING.
- 5. ALL CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT OPERATING IN THE PRESCRIBED CONSTRUCTION AREA IS REQUIRED TO DISPLAY A CHECKERBOARD FLAG PROPERLY LOCATED AS SPECIFIED IN AC 150/5210-5. "PAINTING, MARKING, AND LIGHTING OF VEHICLES USED ON AN AIRPORT" (CURRENT EDITION)
- 6. CLOSED AIRFIELD WORK AREAS, OPEN TRENCHES, AND OTHER HAZARDOUS AREAS AT THE CONSTRUCTION SITE SHALL BE PROMINENTLY MARKED WITH LIGHTED BARRICADES WITH STEADY BURNING OR FLASHING RED LIGHTS AS SPECIFIED IN 150/5370-2, "OPERATIONAL SAFETY ON AIRPORT DURING CONSTRUCTION, LATEST EDITION. LIGHTED BARRICADES MUST BE NO TALLER THAN 18" (EXCLUSIVE OF SUPPLEMENTARY LIGHTS AND FLAGS) ON THE TAXIWAYS AND COMPLY WITH ADVISORY CIRCULAR 150/5370-2, LATEST EDITION. CONTRACTOR SHALL NIGHT CHECK BARRICADES DAILY FOR PROPER OPERATION.
- 7. NO PAVEMENT EDGE DROP-OFFS GREATER THAN 3" ARE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ON ANY ACTIVE AIRFIELD PAVEMENT AREA. TEMPORARY EARTH SHOULDERS SHALL BE PLACED IF AN INCOMPLETE AREA IS TO BE REOPENED TO AIRCRAFT TRAFFIC.
- AIRPORT SECURITY AIRPORT SECURITY WILL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES. NO CONTRACTOR PERSONNEL OR EQUIPMENT WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF THE 8. CONSTRUCTION LIMITS DEPICTED ON THESE PLANS. PERSONAL VEHICLES OF CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES SHALL BE PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED STAGING AREA AND ARE NOT ALLOWED ACCESS ON THE SITE. THE CONTRACTOR WILL CLOSE AND LOCK THE GATE AT THE DESIGNATED CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCE AT THE END OF EACH DAY. ALL CONTRACTOR EMPLOYEES SHALL WEAR A GARMENT IDENTIFYING THEM AS CONSTRUCTION PERSONNEL.
- 9. NO CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT GREATER THAN 25' TALL WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE AIRPORT WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE AIRPORT MANAGER AND AIRSPACE APPROVAL BY THE FAA.
- 10. SOIL, DEBRIS, AND LOOSE MATERIAL DROPPED OR TRUCKED ONTO AIRPORT ROADS, TAXIWAYS, AND SOD SURFACES, OR WHICH CAN BE BLOWN ONTO SUCH SURFACES, SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY SWEPT, PICKED UP AND REMOVED, OR PLACED INTO CLOSED CONTAINERS. ANY DAMAGE TO AIRPORT PROPERTY SHALL BE REPAIRED IMMEDIATELY AT THE CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE
- 11. EACH CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING AND MAINTAINING AIRPORT LIGHTING AND NAVIGATIONAL ELECTRICAL SYSTEMS DURING CONSTRUCTION. A CONTACT PERSON AND TELEPHONE NUMBER FOR 24 HOUR EMERGENCY IMMEDIATE REPAIR SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE AIRPORT MANAGER AND ENGINEER. 


SITE CLEARING PLAN
