PUBLIC MEETING

The Contractor shall schedule and conduct a Public Information Meeting for this project before the start of construction. The Contractor shall secure a suitable accessible facility for the meeting subject to the approval of the Department. The Contractor shall advertise the meeting a minimum of 10 calendar days in advance in at least one local paper, radio station, television station, social media or website to generate as much public participation as possible. The Contractor shall also contact the business owners along the project limits to inform them of the public meeting. The Contractor shall pay for all required insurance and fees associated with the meeting. The Contractor shall have representatives at the meeting to answer questions concerning scheduling, the nature of the work to be performed, and any other issues that may arise. The contractor shall provide notification of the public meeting to the properties within 500 feet of the project area, via door hangers or U.S. mail, a minimum of 10 days before the public meeting.

This work will not be paid for separately but shall be considered included in the cost of the various traffic control items included herein.
