



TYPE II ELASTOMERIC EXP. BRG.

(North Brg. Pier 4)

Notes:

- (1) Anchor bolts shall be ASTM F1554 all-thread or an Engineer approved alternate material of the grade and diameter specified. The corresponding specified grade of AASHTO M314 anchor bolts may be used in lieu of ASTM F1554.
- ② Anchor bolts for Type II bearings shall be placed in holes drilled in the concrete through holes in the bottom bearing plate after members are in place. Side retainers shall be placed after bolts are installed.
- 3 Drilled and set anchor bolts shall be installed according to Article 521.06 of the Standard Specifications.
- 4 Side retainers and other steel members required for the elastomeric bearing assembly shall be included in the cost of Elastomeric Bearing Assembly, Type II.
- (5) 's" PTFE dimpled, unlubricated.
 (6) The 's" PTFE sheet shall be bonded directly to the top steel plate with a two-component, medium viscosity epoxy resin, conforming to the requirements of the Federal Specification MMM-A-134, Type I. The bond agent shall be applied on the full area of the contact surfaces.
- (7) The structural steel plates of the Bearing Assemblies below expansion joints shall conform to the requirements of AASHTO M 270 Grade 50.
- (8) Bonding of '8" PTFE sheet during vulcanizing process will be permitted provided the process and method of adjusting assembly height is approved by the Engineer
- (9) For bearings below expansion joints, all bearing plates, shim plates, and side retainers shall be metallized according to the Special Provision for Metallizing Structural Steel. At the Contractor's option, in lieu of metallizing, the bearing plates, shim plates, and side retainers may be galvanized according to the Special Provision for Hot Dip Galvanizing for Structural Steel.
- (1) Two l_8 in. adjusting shims shall be provided for each bearing in addition to all other plates or shims and placed as shown on bearing details. For bearings below expansion joints, these plates shall be metallized according to the Special Provision for Metallizing Structural Steel. If the galvanizing option is chosen for the bearings, in lieu of metallizing, these shims shall be galvanized according to the Special Provision for Hot Dip Galvanizing for Structural Steel.
- (1) Equivalent rolled angle with stiffeners will be allowed in lieu of welded plates.
