<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of the removal and disposal of regulated substances according to Section 669 of the Standard Specifications as revised below.

<u>Contract Specific Work Areas</u>. For stationing, the lateral distance is measured from centerline and the farthest distance is the offset distance or construction limit, whichever is less.

The following contract specific work areas shall be monitored by the Environmental Firm for soil contamination and workers protection.

ISGS Site 4277-002 - ROW, approximate I-74 M.M. 73.5 to M.M. 73.8, Brimfield and unincorporated Brimfield Township, Peoria County

- Station 186+70 to Station 186+90 (CL I-74 along CH 69), 50 feet LT to 50 feet RT. The
 Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in
 accordance with Article 669.05(c). Contaminants of concern sampling parameters:
 Manganese.
- Station 187+70 to Station 188+90 (CL I-74), 0 feet to 90 feet LT. The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(1). Contaminants of concern sampling parameters: Arsenic and manganese.
- Station 190+40 to Station 191+40 (CL I-74), 50 feet LT to 50 feet RT. The Engineer has determined this material meets the criteria of and shall be managed in accordance with Article 669.05(a)(2). Contaminants of concern sampling parameters: Arsenic and manganese.

Work Zones

Three distinct OSHA HAZWOPER work zones (exclusion, decontamination, and support) shall apply to projects adjacent to or within sites with documented leaking underground storage tank (LUST) incidents, or sites under management in accordance with the requirements of the Site Remediation Program (SRP), Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), or Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), or as deemed necessary. For this project, the work zones apply for the following ISGS PESA Sites: **None**
