RIGHT-OF-WAY RESTRICTIONS

Effective July 1, 1994

Add to Article 107.32: The Contractor shall be permitted to use the State Right-of-Way adjacent to closed lanes or spread median areas for short periods of time (<u>Designer to pick 1, 2, 3 and/or 4</u>).

- 1) between (Lt., Rt., Median) Sta. to
- 2) within the interchange of <u>and</u>
- 3) the intersection of <u>and</u>
- 4) throughout the project limits

(then the Designer picks 1, 2, 3 and/or 4)

- 1) to store materials;
- 2) to stockpile salvaged materials;
- 3) to park construction machinery;
- 4) or to park or allow parking of any workman's vehicles

during the duration of this project.

When lanes are reopened to traffic, the Contractor shall arrange within a reasonable time period to clean up and restore areas where equipment or material has been stored on the Right-of-Way.
