





### **GENERAL NOTES**

All structural steel shall be AASHTO M 270 Grade 36 unless otherwise noted. No field welding is permitted except as specified in the contract documents. Reinforcement bars shall conform to the requirements of ASTM A 706

Gr 60. See Special Provisions.

Reinforcement bars designated (E) shall be epoxy coated.

Prior to pouring the new concrete deck section, all heavy or loose rust, loose mill scale, and other loose or potentially detrimental foreign material shall be removed from the surfaces in contact with concrete. Tightly adhered paint may remain unless otherwise noted. Removal shall be accomplished by methods that will not damage the steel and the cost will be included in the pay item covering removal of the existing concrete.

As directed by the Engineer, existing construction accessories welded to the top flange of beams and girders shall be removed. The weld areas shall be ground flush and inspected for cracks using magnetic particle testing (MT) or dye penetrant testing (PT) by qualified personnel approved by the Engineer.

Any cracks that cannot be removed by grinding  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch deep shall be identified and reported to the Bureau of Bridges and Structures for further disposition. The cost of removing welded accessories, grinding and inspecting weld areas and grinding cracks will be paid for according to Article 109.04 of the Standard Specifications.

Plan dimensions and details relative to existing plans are subject to nominal construction variations. The Contractor shall field verify existing dimensions and details affecting new construction and make necessary approved adjustments prior to construction or ordering of materials. Such variations shall not be cause for additional compensation for a change in scope of the work, however, the Contractor will be paid for the quantity actually furnished at the unit price bid for the work.

The existing structural steel coating contains lead. The Contractor shall take appropriate precautions to deal with the presence of lead on this project.

Existing structural steel shall only be cleaned and painted as required by the Special Provision "Cleaning and Painting Adjacent Areas of Existing Steel Structures" The Inorganic zinc rich primer / Acrylic / Acrylic Paint System shall be used for

shop and field painting of new structural steel except where otherwise noted. The color of the Acrylic finish coat shall be Interstate Green, Munsell No. 7.5G 4/8. See Special Provisions for "Cleaning and Painting New Metal Structures".

Existing reinforcement bars extending into the removal area shall be cleaned, straightened and incorporated into the new construction. Any reinforcement bars that are damaged during concrete removal shall be replaced with an approved bar splicer or anchorage system. Cost included with Concrete Removal.

Joint openings shall be adjusted according to Article 520.04 of the Std. Specs. when the deck is poured at an ambient temperature other than 50°F.













DRAIN ELIMINATION DETAIL

Removal and and re-erection of the existing aluminum handrail, rail post, and all new applicable hardware, including labor and installation shall be included in the cost of Concrete Removal.



### BAR SPLICER ASSEMBLY FOR #5 BAR ON INTEGRAL OR SEMI-INTEGRAL ABUTMENTS







Detail I - With Bar Splicer or Couplers:

Connect one (1) 1"x7"x10" steel \( \mathbb{P} \) to the top layer of couplers with 2-\( \frac{5}{8} \)" \( \phi \) bolts screwed to coupler at approximate \( \hat{Q} \) of each barrier panel.

Detail II - With Extended Reinforcement Bars:

Connect one (1) 1'x7''x 10'' steel ₱ to the concrete slab or concrete wearing surface with 2-58'' ∮


Expansion Anchors or cast in place inserts spaced between the top layer of reinforcement at approximate ₤ of each barrier panel.


Cost of anchorage is included with Temporary Concrete Barrier. The  $1^{\prime\prime}$  x  $7^{\prime\prime}$  x  $10^{\prime\prime}$  plate shall not be removed until stage II construction forms and all reinforcement bars are in place and the concrete is ready to be placed.

### SECTIONS THRU SLAB OR DECK BEAM

- \*\*\* Dimension shown is minimum required embedment into concrete.

  If hot-mix asphalt wearing surface is present, minimum embedment shall be in addition to wearing surface depth.
- \*\*\*\* If existing deck beam is to remain in place after stage construction, embedment shall only be into wearing surface and not into existing deck beam concrete.
