The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has authorized the above-referenced project under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act, as described in your notification and as shown on "Proposed Highway Plan – F.A.P. 856 (Weber Road) – Section 14-00170-42-RP – Weber Road from 135th Street/Romeo Road to Normantown Road – Project M-4003(709) – Widening and Reconstruction – Will County – C-91-246-16" dated April 22, 2016, prepared by Thomas Engineering Group. Enclosed is your copy of the executed permit which becomes effective on the date of this letter.

This determination covers only your project as described above. If the design, location, or purpose of the project is changed, you should contact this office to determine the need for further authorization. 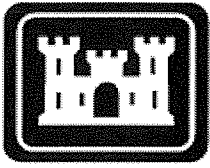
