NOTES:

1. EROSION CONTROL TO BE IN PLACE BEFORE START OF WORK AND TO REMAIN IN PLACE UNTIL ENGINEER DIRECTS TO REMOVE. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR IMMEDIATE REPAIR/MAINTENANCE OF EROSION CONTROL ITEMS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
2. DITCH CHECKS SPACED AT APPROXIMATELY 100' INTERVALS. DITCH CHECKS SHALL ALSO BE USED AT FLARED END INLET STRUCTURES.
3. INITIALLY TRAFFIC FLOW IN BOTH DIRECTIONS WILL BE LOCATED ON THE SOUTHBOUND LANES DURING CONSTRUCTION OF NORTHBOUND LANES.
4. AFTER CONSTRUCTION OF NORTHBOUND LANES ARE COMPLETED TRAFFIC FLOW WILL BE DIVERTED TO NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND LANES DURING FINAL STAGES OF CONSTRUCTION.
