



- GENERAL NOTES:
- 1) DRUMS OR BARRICADES SHALL BE LOCATED ON THE EXISTING EDGE OF PAVEMENT DURING WORKING HOURS AND SHALL BE LOCATED OFF OF THE EXISTING EDGE OF PAVEMENT DURING NON-WORKING HOURS. EXTENDED LEG BARRICADES WITH LIGHTS ARE REQUIRED WHERE THE EDGE DROP OFF IS 3" OR GREATER. LIGHTS SHALL BE STEADY BURNING WHERE THE LENGTH OF THE WORKZONE IS GREATER THAN 100'.
 - 2) ACCESS TO PRIVATE PROPERTY SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES.
 - 3) LOCATION OF THE ARROW BOARD MAY NEED ADJUSTMENT IF IT CANNOT FIT WITHIN THE BARRICADES.
