CONSTRUCTION METHODS

Delete this section and substitute the following in its place:

“There are two taxi guidance signs located at the holding lines on the two cross-over taxiways to Runway 18-36. The east side of these two signs requires the sign panels to be replaced. Both sign panels currently have white lettering on a red background. The panels furnished by the Contractor shall be Type L-858-R

mandatory instruction signs (black outline on outside edge of white legend on red background) except for any blanks that may be required and these will be black.

The Northernmost taxi guidance sign was manufactured by Airfield Guidance and is a size 1, style 2 guidance sign. The east side currently reads **36-18**. The Contractor will change this panel to read **18**. It will be the Contractor's responsibility to determine if an additional blank panel will be required. The west side of this sign is correct and nothing will be done to it.

The Southernmost taxi guidance sign was manufactured by Crouse-Hinds and is a size 1, style 2 guidance sign. The east side currently reads **18-36**. The Contractor will change this panel to read **36-18**. The west side of this sign is correct and nothing will be done to it.

The removed panels will be turned over to the Airport Manager. If any sign or other electrical equipment is damaged during the panel replacement, it will be the Contractor's responsibility to repair or replace this equipment with similar approved equipment at no additional cost to the contract."
