- NOTES:**
1. THE EXISTING MEDIAN PLANTING BED CONSISTS OF 18" PLANTING MIX AND 8" POROUS GRANULAR EMBANKMENT (DEPTHS ARE APPROXIMATE) AND SHALL REMAIN. THE PROPOSED PLANTING BED AT TREE LOCATIONS SHALL CONSIST OF 36" PLANTING MIX. SEE PROPOSED LANDSCAPE MEDIAN SECTION A-A AND B-B FOR ADDITIONAL DETAIL. EXCAVATION AT THE FOUR TREE LOCATIONS SHALL BE PAID FOR AS REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF UNSUITABLE MATERIAL (90 CU YD).
 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE ALL NECESSARY TRAFFIC CONTROL REQUIRED FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROJECT OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THE COST OF INDIVIDUAL IDOT TRAFFIC CONTROL STANDARDS SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY, BUT SHALL BE INCLUDED IN "TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION (SPECIAL)".
 3. ADVANCE SIGNING AND TAPERS FOR TEMPORARY DAYTIME LANE CLOSURES SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH IDOT STANDARD 701601 OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
 4. WORK ZONE MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH IDOT STANDARD 701701 OR AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
 5. PLACEMENT OF THE BATTERY OPERATED IRRIGATION CONTROLLER SHALL BE COORDINATED WITH TREE PLACEMENT.
