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### **SEEDING CLASS 2 OR 2A**

Effective: February 5, 1975 Revised: February 6, 2007

All disturbed areas are to be seeded.

The seed mixtures shall be modified as follows:

Seeding Class 2 – Inferno Tall Fescue or Tarheel II Tall Fescue shall be replaced with Alta Fescue or KY31 at 100 lb/acre (110 kg/ha).

Seeding Class 2A – Inferno Tall Fescue or Tarheel II Tall Fescue shall be replaced with Alta Fescue or KY31 at 60 lb/acre (70 kg/ha). Dawsons Red may be substituted for Audobon Red Fescue at 30 lb/acre (35 kg/ha).

When Class 2 seeding is done between March 1<sup>st</sup> and June 1st, the seed mixture shall also include 48 pounds per acre (55kg/ha) of Spring Oats.

When Class 2 seeding is done between August 1st and November 15th, the seed mixture shall also include 56 pounds per acre (63kg/ha) of Balboa Farm Rye or 60 pounds per acre (67kg/ha) of Winter Wheat.

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per acre (hectare) for SEEDING CLASS 2 or SEEDING CLASS 2A.

The amount of Seeding Class 2 or 2A shown in the contract has been estimated. The Contractor will be paid for the amount actually seeded, at the contract unit price bid per acre (hectare), as directed by the Engineer.

#### TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

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## **RESTRICTIONS ON PROPOSED LANE CLOSURES**

The Contractor shall verify with the Engineer the precise location of each proposed lane closure twenty-four (24) hours prior to possibly closing the lane. The location of the lane closure shall become subject to the approval of the Engineer with respect to the other active contracts working in the vicinity. The Engineer shall coordinate the lane closure such that the cooperation of the contractors minimizes the disruption to the traveling public. If the said notice is not provided, lane closures will not be permitted.

No additional compensation will be allowed for this coordination.
