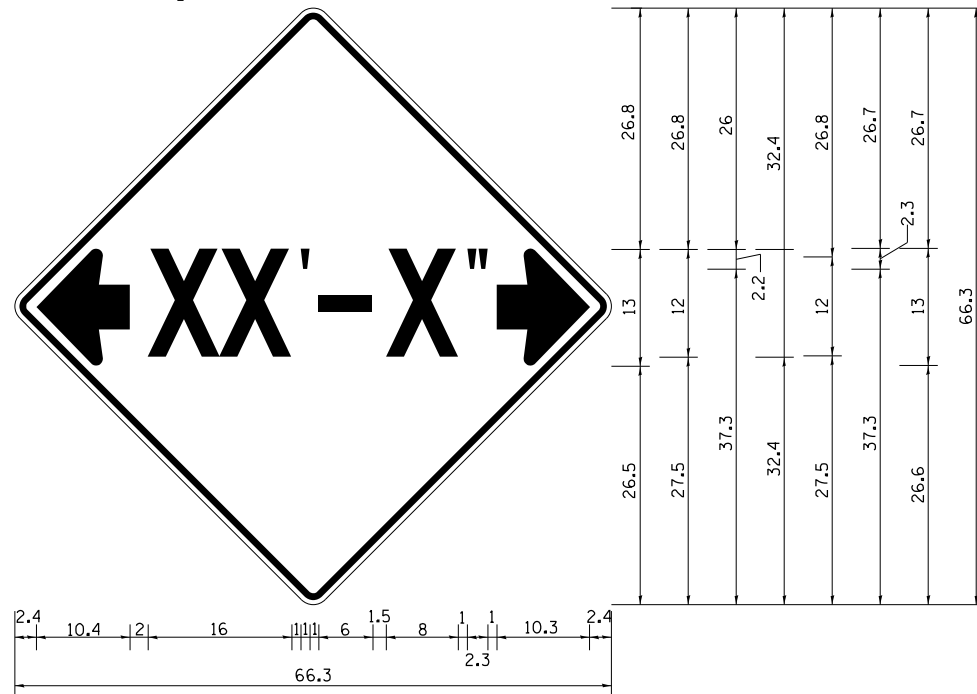
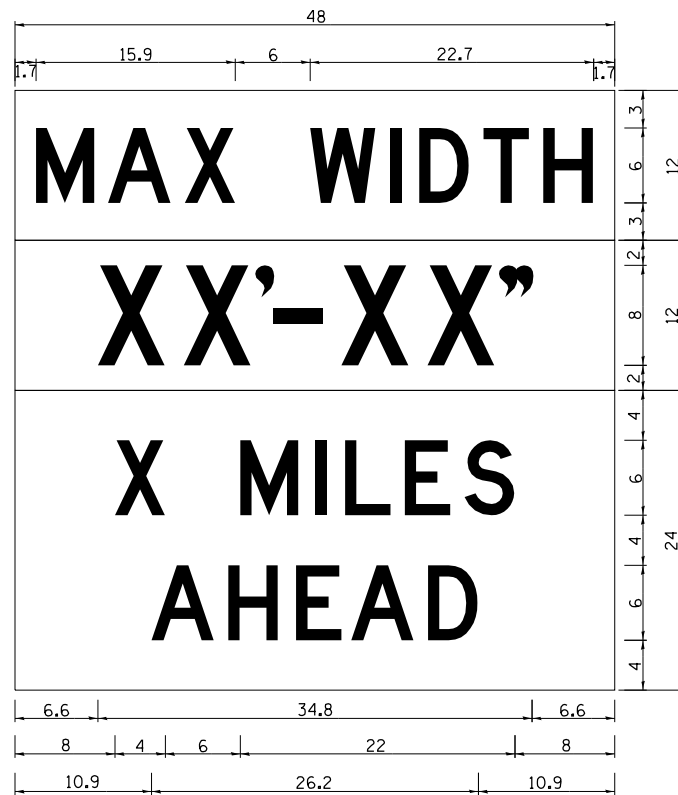

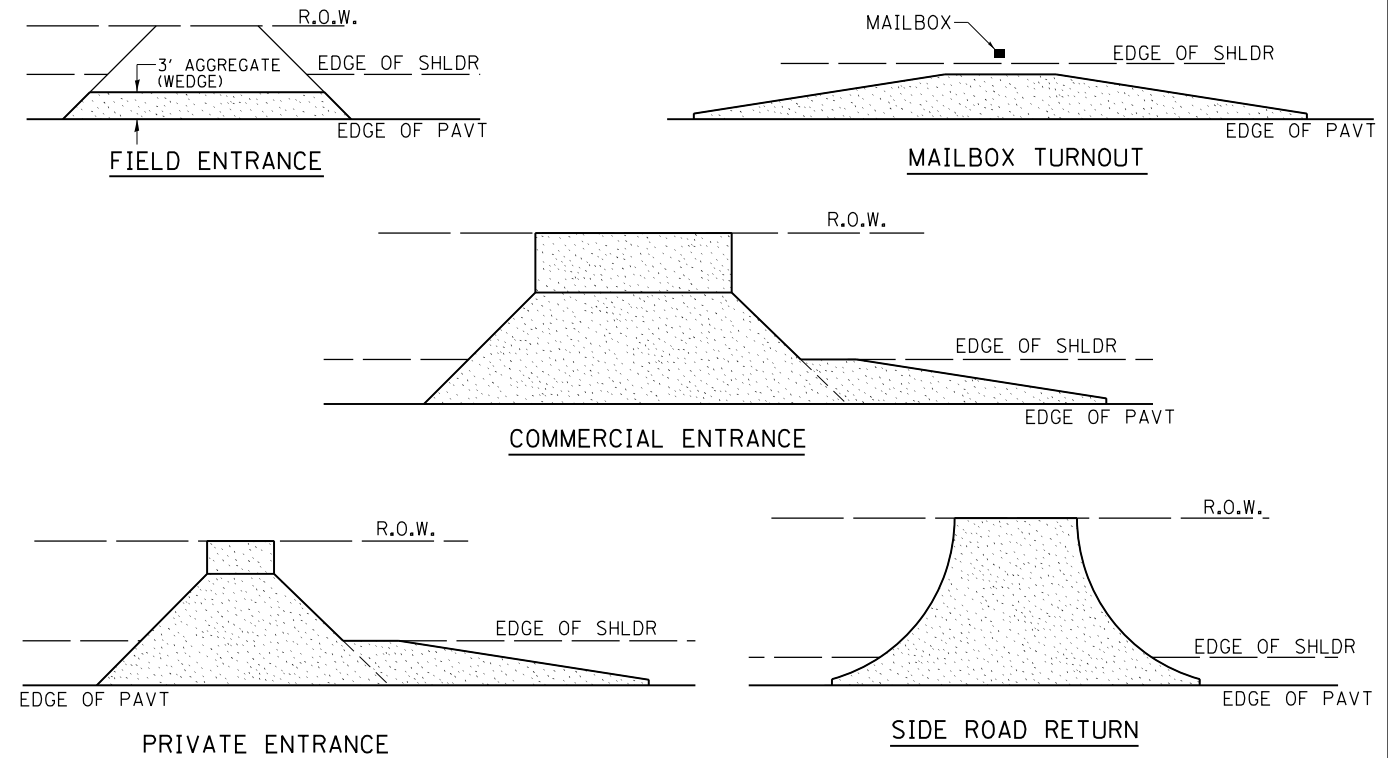

HOT-MIX ASPHALT APPROACHES & MAILBOX RETURNS FOR TWO LIFT (3P) RESURFACING PROJECTS

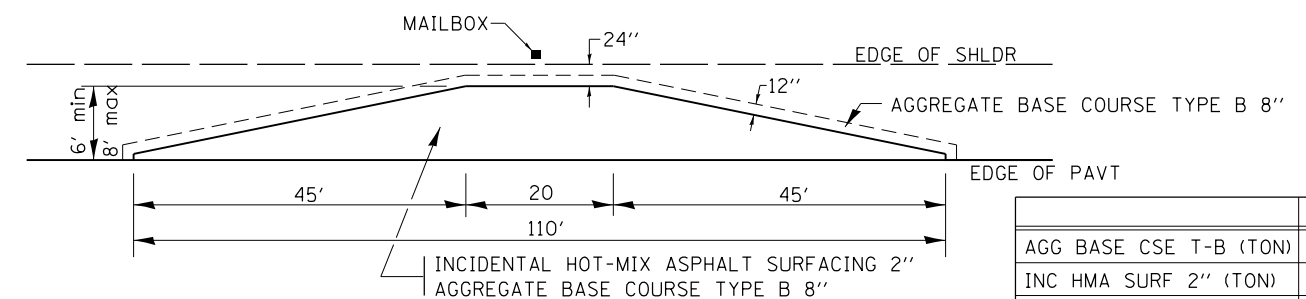


NOTE: EXISTING HMA PE's, CE's, SR's, & MB TURNOUTS

 Place 3" Incidental Hot-Mix Asphalt Surfacing #40800050 on sideroad to conform to the present configuration.
