LAKE COUNTY DIVISION OF TRANSPORTATION (LCDOT) PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

A LCDOT Permit is required for work within Lake County Right-of-Way along Peterson Road.

The work includes the installation of the proposed detour signage along Peterson Road west of U.S. Route 45.

The Contractor will be required to provide an acceptable Proof of Insurance and Performance Guarantee for the work in accordance with the County's Highway Access Ordinance. Insurance requirements include adding Lake County Division of Transportation, its employees and its agents, and the county of Lake, its employees and its agents, as additional insured to the Contractor's General Liability Insurance. Upon execution of the contract, the contractor shall provide a Person-in-Charge letter to LCDOT.
