Justification for use of a Project Labor Agreement on FAI 255 Contract Number 76K05, St. Clair County which is the rehabilitation of I-255 from IL 15 to IL 157 in Cahokia Heights.

Federal Project Number: NHPP-BDE6(677)

ITEM 3: Estimated project cost is \$74,300,000.

This project includes patching and resurfacing of the existing PCC pavement, significant bridge repairs, new pavement markings, safety improvement, signing, lighting and all other necessary and collateral work to complete the project as shown on the plans and as specified elsewhere in these provisions.

ITEM 8: The construction of this project is being performed under a full closure of I-255 from IL 15 to IL 157. Labor continuity will minimize the amount of time the traveling public is inconvenienced by the full closure of I-255. The contractor will be allowed to close I-255 as soon as February 1, 2025 and will have a completion date of July 31, 2025, with an incentive/disincentive clause.

Any work stoppage during construction will extend the length of the construction project and the amount of time that the full closure work zone is in place, thus reducing the overall safety of the alternate route roadways to the traveling public.
