**GENERAL NOTES**

IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS & CONDITIONS EXISTING IN THE FIELD PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION & ORDERING OF MATERIALS.

THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4151 OR 4155 FOR EXPRESSWAYS, AND (847) 705-4470 FOR ARTERIALS A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.

WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS UTILIZED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND ADJOINING RESIDENTIAL AREA.

IT SHALL BE THE CONTRACTORS RESPONSIBILITY TO PROTECT AND MAINTAIN THE EXISTING BRIDGE LIGHTING AT ALL LOCATIONS.

THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR "TEMPORARY INFORMATION SIGNING FOR LANE CLOSURES" AND "PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND SAFETY" ARE APPLICABLE ONLY TO ARTERIAL ROADS AND SHALL NOT BE APPLIED TO EXPRESSWAYS.

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO ABUTTING PROPERTY AT ALL TIMES DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT.
