Type A metal post (two for each sign) conforming to Article 1006.29 of the Standard Specifications may be used in lieu of wood posts. Type A metal posts used for these signs may be unfinished.

This work shall not be paid for separately; but shall be considered included in the cost of the traffic control items in this contract.

REMOVE IMPACT ATTENUATORS, NO SALVAGE

This work shall consist of removing all the existing impact attenuators within the project limits. The Contractor shall dispose of the impact attenuators and debris according to Article 202.03.

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per EACH for REMOVE IMPACT ATTENUATORS, NO SALVAGE. Each attenuator must be replaced the same day it is removed.

This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per each for REMOVE IMPACT ATTENUATORS, NO SALVAGE.

IMPACT ATTENUATORS

IMPACT ATTENUATORS (PARTIALLY REDIRECTIVE), TEST LEVEL 3 shall be constructed in accordance with Supplemental Specification IMPACT ATTENUATORS, except that the last sentence shall be modified to read "Regarding of the slopes or approaches shall be in accordance with the details in the plans. This grading work shall be considered included in the cost of IMPACT ATTENUATORS (PARTIALLY REDIRECTIVE), TEST LEVEL 3 and no additional compensation will be allowed."

STATUS OF UTILITIES TO BE ADJUSTED

NO UTILITIES TO BE ADJUSTED

The above represents the best information of the Department and is only included for the convenience of the bidder. The applicable provisions of Sections 102, 103, and Articles 105.07 and 107.20 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction shall apply.

If any utility adjustment or removal has not been completed when required by the Contractor's operation, the Contractor should notify the Engineer in writing. A request for an extension of time will be considered to the extent the Contractor's operations were affected.
