2) The Project is being constructed using state or local funds only (i.e., no federal funds
☑ 3) The overall size, scope, sequencing, logistics or other aspects of the Project make it articularly challenging to manage, and use of a PLA is expected to help assure that the onstruction work is performed properly and efficiently under the circumstances.
☑ 4) The duration of construction activity on the Project is expected to exceed one onstruction season (i.e., 110 or more working days), or the nature of the Project results in a eightened need for labor force continuity and stability over a substantial period of time.
X_5) There is a firm construction completion date established for the Project thereby acreasing the adverse consequences of any work stoppage or other labor disruption.
X_ 6) The time required to complete the Project is expected to extend beyond the expiration ate of one or more existing collective bargaining agreements covering trades likely to be avolved in the Project, thereby increasing the likelihood of work stoppage(s) or other labor isruption(s) during construction of the Project.

Justification for use of project Labor Agreement on Contract 70B98, Champaign County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project Description: This project is for the reconstruction of the structure carrying US 150 over FAI 74. Other improvements associated with the project include sidewalk, paving, guardrail removal and replacement, earthwork, seeding and mulch, pavement markings, and raised reflective pavement markers.
