Justification for use of Project Labor Agreement on Contract 66C45 Iroquois County:

The use of a project Labor Agreement on this project is consistent with all State and Local statutory regulatory requirements.

Project duration: 50 working days

### **Project Description:**

This is a milling and resurfacing project. The work consists of milling at 3.75" and resurfacing with 2.25" HMA Binder and 1.5" of HMA surface course. The project also includes patching and drainage improvements. It extends from the Ford County line to 0.3 miles west of I-57.

#### Item 3:

Estimated project cost is \$5,900,000. The project is anticipated to require most of the construction season to construct. Any disruption in the continuity of this project due to labor issues could result in the delay of deadlines which would cause safety concerns for the travelling public. It is the Illinois Department of Transportation's finding that the large skilled workforce needed for this project can be provided by union trades involved and is a necessary requirement for a Project Labor Agreement

#### Item 9:

The use of a PLA on this project will result in improved access to skilled labor, improved efficiency and improved safety performance because it will assist in coordinating the labor forces of five separate trade unions that may be involved in its construction efforts.
