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## RAMP CLOSURES WITH DETOUR

Ramp closures with detours shall be utilized for completing ramp connections and other staging requirements shown in the Plans. This work shall consist of furnishing, maintaining, and removing all traffic control devices for the ramps in accordance with this special provision.

The Contractor shall close the ramps using Traffic Control and Protection Standard 701451, District 5 Standard **70103710** and the details shown in the plans. The District 5 Traffic Operations Department shall be notified (217-466-7294) at least 3 working days – 72 hours (weekends and holidays do not count into these 3 working days – 72 hours notification) in advance of the proposed road closures and shall be coordinated by the Contractor with the Engineer.

The following are the locations and durations of closures allowable:

I-72, Stage1 Construction

Ramp C: I-57 NB to I-72 WB - 8 months Ramp D: I-72 WB to I-57 SB - 8 months

I-72, Stage 2 Construction

Ramp A: I-57 NB to I-72 EB - 8 months Ramp B: I-72 EB to I-57 NB - 8 months

These allowable ramp closures have been identified to assist the Contractor in completing the mainline pavement work in conjunction with the ramp terminal connections without traffic on the adjacent ramps. Most of the work required for excavation, paving operations and associated drainage is anticipated to be completed while the ramps are closed.

These closures will not be measured separately for payment but shall be included in the contract lump sum price for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION (SPECIAL). This price shall include all labor, materials, and equipment required to furnish, install, maintain, and remove all traffic control devices and signs associated with the road closures as detailed herein. Traffic Control and Protection Standard 701451 and District 5 Standard 70103710 will not be measured separately for payment when used in accordance with the requirements above but shall be included in the contract lump sum price for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION (SPECIAL) with no additional compensation allowed.
