ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS

Prior to the use of any proposed borrow areas, use areas (temporary access roads, detours, run-arounds, etc.) and/or waste areas, the Contractor shall file the required environmental resource request surveys according to Section 107.22 of the Standard Specifications. These surveys are required in order for the Department to conduct cultural and biological resource surveys for the proposed site.

Prior to any waste materials being removed from the construction site the required environmental resource surveys will need to be obtained and filed by the Contractor. Excess waste products removed from the construction site shall be disposed of as required in Section 202.03 of the Standard Specifications.

Any protruding metal bars shall be removed prior to the disposal of broken concrete at approved disposal sites.

The required environmental resource documentation shall include the following:

- * BDE Form 2289 (Environmental Survey Request)
- * A location map showing the size limits and location of the use area
- * Signed property owner agreement form-D4 PI0100
- * Color photographs depicting the use area
- * Borrow Area Entry Agreement form-D4 PI0101

Please note that a minimum of two weeks shall be allowed for the District to obtain the required environmental clearances.

PROJECT SPECIFIC NOTES

All signs which are removed and not reinstalled shall be delivered to the Illinois Department of Transportation facility at the following location.

Existing sign posts which are removed shall become the property of the contractor and be disposed of in accordance with Article 202.03 of the Standard Specifications.

The top 3" of all holes constructed in existing islands or medians for the installation of sign posts shall be filled with cold mix asphalt. This work shall not be paid for separately but shall be included in the agreed unit price bid for WOOD SIGN SUPPORT.

When the area of any sign, or combination of signs, is equal to or greater than twenty (20) square feet two (2) posts are required for installation.
