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Disposal of material shall be done in accordance with Section 440.06 of the Standard Specifications.

<u>Method of Measurement</u>. Approach Slab and Shoulder Removal will be measured in place for payment in square yards of approach slab removed regardless of replacement area. Full depth sawcutting shall not be measured separately for payment.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>. Approach slab removal will be paid for at the contract unit price per square yards for APPROACH SLAB REMOVAL, which price shall include full depth sawcutting, pavement removal, disposal of debris, and all labor, equipment, and materials required to complete the work specified herein.

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TEMPORARY SUPPORT SYSTEM

<u>Description.</u> This work shall consist of furnishing all material, equipment and labor for the design, construction and subsequent removal of a Temporary Support System. Included under this item shall be all work to support the vertical abutments which will be subject to horizontal earth loads during superstructure replacement operations and the bridge deck during removal of the bituminous patch along each abutment joint.

<u>General.</u> The design calculations and details for the Temporary Support System proposed by the Contractor shall be submitted to the Engineer for approval. The calculations shall be prepared and sealed by an Illinois Licensed Structural Engineer. This approval will not relieve the Contractor of responsibility for the adequacy of the support system. Any damage to the abutments caused by the attachment of the Temporary Support System shall be repaired subject to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

<u>Existing Conditions.</u> An Existing Structure Information Package (ESIP) will be provided by the Department to the Contractor upon request. This package will typically include existing or "As-Built" plans. The availability of structural information from the Department is solely for the convenience and information of the Contractor and shall not relieve the Contractor of the duty to make, and the risk of making, examinations and investigations as required to assess conditions affecting the work. Any data furnished in the ESIP is for information only and does not constitute a part of the Contract. The Department makes no representation or warranty, express or implied, as to the information conveyed or as to any interpretations made from the data.
