CONCRETE GUTTER, TYPE A (SPECIAL)

Description. This work shall consist of constructing a type A gutter at the locations shown on the plans, in accordance with Section 606 of the Standard Specifications; the Concrete Gutter Type A (Modified Special) detail shown on the plan sheets below Typical Section No. 4; and Standard 606101.

Highway Standard 606101 shall still apply, except Section D-D shall be modified to reflect the detail provided in the proposed typical sections.

Method of Measurement. Measured quantities will be according to Article 606.14(b) of the Standard Specifications.

Basis of Payment. This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per FOOT for CONCRETE GUTTER, TYPE A (SPECIAL).

WIDTH RESTRICTION AND MAXIMUM WIDTH SIGNING

Effective: December 7, 1999

Revised: January 31, 2024

Description. This work shall consist of furnishing, erecting, maintaining, covering, uncovering and removing maximum width signing as shown in the plans.

Construction Requirements. The work within this contract will cause a width restriction requiring notification of a minimum of 21 days prior to the actual width restriction and/or event requiring "Maximum Width" signing. Where construction operations result in allowed lane restriction widths less than 16'-0", advance post mounted warning signs shall be provided. Sign panels shall read "MAX WIDTH, XX MILES AHEAD" (W12-I103); "X-X" (W12-I102); and arrow plates (as applicable). All "Maximum Width" signing shall be furnished, erected, maintained and removed by the Contractor for placement at the locations below:

- WB 104 – 1000' East of IL 104/99
- EB 104 – 1000' West of 104/99
- SB IL 99 – In Versailles 500' 2nd Street
- SB IL 99 – 500' North of 1465 E. Street
- EB US 24 – In Mt Sterling 1000' West of US24/IL107/99 JCT
- WB US 24 – In Mt Sterling 1000' East of US24/IL107/99 JCT



Width restrictions shall be interpreted as any change in the existing horizontal clearance caused by the placement of physical barrier(s) that extend above the pavement surface. Construction activities which close a lane with operating equipment or with drums, barricades, or cones will not be considered as width restrictions. Equipment, such as paving machines, or channelizing devices can and shall be temporarily moved aside if a wide load arrives.

Notification of width restriction requires a minimum of 21 days before the actual restriction is placed to ensure specific routed over-width permitted loads are not sent through the restriction site. The Contractor shall notify the Engineer a minimum of 21 days prior to the width restriction.
