### GENERAL NOTES - ROADWAY

- 1. BEFORE STARTING ANY EXCAVATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL "J. U. L. I. E." AT (800) 892-0123 FOR FIELD LOCATIONS OF BURIED ELECTRIC, TELEPHONE AND GAS UTILITIES. (48 HOUR NOTIFICATION IS REQUIRED.)
- 2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WITH UTILITY COMPANIES, AND THE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY.
- THE CONTRACTOR WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SET UP A YARD OR FIELD OFFICE ON STATE PROPERTY WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE DEPARTMENT.
- 4. ALL DAMAGE TO EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING OR RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS OUTSIDE THE REMOVAL LINE SHOWN ON THE PLANS SHALL BE REPLACED AT THE CONTRACTORS EXPENSE.
- 5. WHEN MILLED PAVEMENT IS OPENED TO TRAFFIC THE MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL BETWEEN PASSES OF THE MILLING MACHINE SHALL NOT EXCEED 1\*INCHES WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS 45 MPH OR LESS AND 1 INCH WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS GREATER THAN 45 MPH. WITH WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE ENGINEER, A MAXIMUM GRADE DIFFERENTIAL OF 3 INCHES MAY BE ALLOWED IF THE EDGE OF THE MILLING IS SLOPED A MINIMUM 1:3 (V:H).
- BUTT JOINTS WILL BE INSTALLED AT THE ENDS OF ALL RESURFACING (WHERE RESURFACING MEETS EXISTING PAVEMENT). IN ACCORDANCE WITH "BUTT JOINT AND HOT- MIX ASPHALT TAPER DETAILS" SHEET INCLUDED IN THE PLANS. UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED.
- 7. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONTACT THE DISTRICT ONE TRAFFIC CONTROL SUPERVISOR AT (847) 705-4470 A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF BEGINNING WORK.
- 8. WHEN ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING IS UTILIZED IN NIGHT OPERATIONS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL EXERCISE THE UTMOST PRECAUTIONS IN PREVENTING ADVERSE VISIBILITY TO THE MOTORING PUBLIC AND ADJOINING RESIDENTIAL AREA.
- 9. BEFORE BEGINNING ANY WORK, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RETAIN AND RECORD (FOR FUTURE REFERENCES). ALL EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING LINES AND RAISED REFLECTIVE PAVEMENT MARKERS IN ORDER THAT THESE LOCATIONS CAN BE RE- ESTABLISHED FOR STRIPING, EXACT LOCATIONS OF ALL STRIPING SHALL BE AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 10. THE ENGINEER SHALL CONTACT ERIC CAMPOS, IDOT'S AREA TRAFFIC FIELD ENGINEER FOR WILL COUNTY, VIA EMAIL AT ERIC. CAMPOS@ILLINOIS. GOV OR AT (8:5) 485-6475 A MINIMUM OF TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS.
- 11. THE "ADVANCE WARNING SIGN DETAIL FOR ARTERIAL TRAFFIC" LOCATED IN THE SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR "TEMPORARY INFORMATION SIGNING FOR LANE CLOSURES" IS APPLICABLE ONLY TO ARTERIAL ROADS.
- 12. DO NOT SCALE PLANS FOR CONSTRUCTION DIMENSIONS.
- 13. THESE PLANS HAVE BEEN PREPARED FROM NOTES RECEIVED FROM DISTRICT 1 BRIDGE INSPECTORS.
- 14. SAW CUTTING OF PAVEMENTS, SHOULDERS, ETC., SHALL BE TO FULL DEPTH AND SHALL RESULT IN A CLEAN, STRAIGHT EDGE ON THE PORTION REMAINING. THE COST OF SAW CUTTING REMOVAL ITEMS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE UNIT PRICES OF THESE ITEMS.
- 15. PLAN DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS RELATIVE TO EXISTING PLANS ARE SUBJECT TO ROUTINE VARIATION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FIELD VERIFY EXISTING DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS AFFECTING NEW CONSTRUCTION OR ORDERING MATERIALS. SUCH VARIATION SHALL NOT CAUSE FOR ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION FOR A CHANGE IN THE SCOPE OF THE WORK, HOWEVER, THE CONTRACTOR WILL BE PAID FOR QUANTITY ACTUALLY FURNISHED BASED AT THE UNIT PRICE BID FOR THE WORK.

## GENERAL NOTES - TRAFFIC CONTROL & PROTECTION

- 1. TRAFFIC CONDITIONS, ACCIDENTS AND OTHER UNFORESEEN EMERGENCY CONDITIONS MAY REQUIRE THE ENGINEER TO RESTRICT, MODIFY OR REMOVE LANE CLOSURES OF . CHANNELIZATION SHOWN IN THE PLANS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAKE THE NECESSARY ADJUSTMENTS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER WITHOUT DELAY. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL RESPOND TO ANY REQUEST MADE BY THE ENGINEER FOR CORRECTION WITHIN TWO HOURS FROM THE TIME OF NOTIFICATION.
- 2. ALL TEMPORARY PAVEMENT MARKINGS PROPOSED WITHIN THE WORK AREA SHALL BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO THE CONSTRUCTION PHASE CHANGE.








