Filter fabric will be measured for payment according to Article 282.08.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per SQUARE YARD for ARTICLUATED BLOCK REVETMENT MAT.

Filter fabric will be paid for according to Article 282.09.

#### PAVEMENT REMOVAL

<u>Description</u>. This work shall consist of removing existing pavement at the locations shown in the plans. This work shall be performed in accordance with Section 440 of the Standard Specifications and as described herein.

The Contractor shall carefully protect and preserve the existing concrete closure slabs and appurtenances and avoid any damage to them during pavement removal operations and throughout the duration of the project. As soon as the Contractor has exposed and cleaned the entire surface of the existing concrete closure slabs of the north and south floodgates, the Contractor shall obtain and provide accurate vertical elevations in the field at each closure slab for the critical 13 locations at each slab as shown on the existing plans. The Contractor shall provide this vertical elevation data and locations to the Design Engineer of Record and USACE.

After evaluating these elevations obtained in the field from the Contractor, the Design Engineer of Record may need to adjust the proposed roadway centerline profile and superelevation data slightly to accommodate the actual closure slab elevations found in the field.

The Contractor shall allow up to three business days for the existing closure slab elevation evaluation and any roadway centerline profile and superelevation data changes to be shown on the plans.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>. This work shall not be measured and paid for separately but shall be included in the contract unit price per SQUARE YARD for PAVEMENT REMOVAL.

#### HOT-MIX ASPHALT SURFACE REMOVAL W/SKETCH OF ILLINOIS STANDARD W8-1107

Effective: October 1, 1985 Revised: February 7, 2020

This work shall consist of removing bituminous surface to the limits specified on the plans according to Section 440 of the Standard Specifications, except as herein modified.

Concrete patches which have to be partially removed will be paid for as hot-mix asphalt surface removal.

Manholes and valve vaults which are exposed by the HMA surface removal and transverse cuts at the end of the day which are more than 1/2 inch deep shall be tamped with a bituminous cold mix. The cost of this temporary taper shall be included in hot-mix asphalt surface removal.

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# TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL)

<u>Description</u>: Specific traffic control plan details and special provisions have been prepared for this contract. Traffic control shall be in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the National Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, Illinois Supplement to the National Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, these special provisions, and any special details and highway standards contained herein and in the plans. This work shall include all labor, materials, equipment, transportation, handling, and incidental work necessary for surveillance and to furnish, install, maintain, relocate, and remove all traffic control devices required within the project work area as indicated in the plans and as indicated by the Engineer.

At road closure locations where type III barricades are installed in a manner that will not allow Contractor access to the project without relocation of one or more of the barricades, the arrangement of the barricades at the beginning of each workday may be relocated, when approved by the Engineer, in the manner shown on Highway Standard 701901 for Road Closed to Thru Traffic.

The Contractor shall place additional traffic control whenever conditions warrant or whenever requested to do so by the Engineer.

Basis of Measurement: This work will be measured for payment on a lump sum basis.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>: This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per LUMP SUM for TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION, (SPECIAL).

Changeable message signs will be paid for separately.

## **TEMPORARY CONCRETE BARRIER (SPECIAL)**

<u>Description.</u> This work shall consist of furnishing and installing new temporary concrete barrier in accordance with Section 704 of the Standard Specifications except that any temporary concrete barrier wall will remain in place after completion of the project.

Barrier to be provided shall be new and free of damage. Barrier shall be pinned according to the Standard Specifications and Standard 704001.

The cost of furnishing and installing the white reflectorized paint and type C reflectors will not be measured and paid for separately but shall be included in the cost of the temporary concrete barrier (special).

<u>Basis of Measurement</u>: This work will be measured for payment in lineal feet in place along the centerline of the barrier.

<u>Basis of Payment</u>. This work will be paid for at the contract unit price per FOOT for TEMPORARY CONCRETE BARRIER (SPECIAL).
